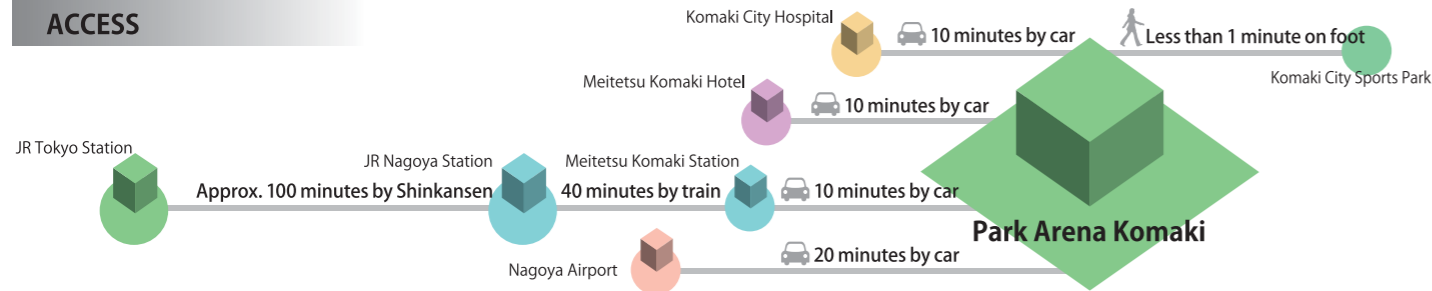

Sightseeing spots in the vicinity: Within 10 minutes by car from the arena

- 1. Mount Komaki (national historic site)**
It is a small mountain with an elevation of 85.9 meters above sea level. You can enjoy cherry blossoms in spring, colorful foliage in autumn, and other views according to the season. During the Sengoku Period, Oda Nobunaga first built a castle on Mount Komaki. Later, the castle became the main camp for the allies of Tokugawa Ieyasu and Oda Nobukatsu during the battle of Komaki/Nagakute.
- 2. Komaki City Historical Museum (a 15 minute walk from the parking area)**
Situated at the top of Mount Komaki. You can enjoy a 360-degree panoramic view that Oda Nobunaga and Tokugawa Ieyasu also enjoyed. In the museum, archaeological, folk and historic materials of Komaki City and a panorama model of the battle of Komaki/Nagakute are displayed.
- 3. Menard Art Museum**
This museum houses about 1,400 pieces of art that were collected by the founding couple of Nippon Menard Cosmetic Co., Ltd., including paintings by Manet, Gogh, Picasso, Yokoyama Taikan, Kishida Ryusei, as well as sculptures and crafts. You can fully appreciate about 70 excellent pieces of art in a quiet atmosphere.

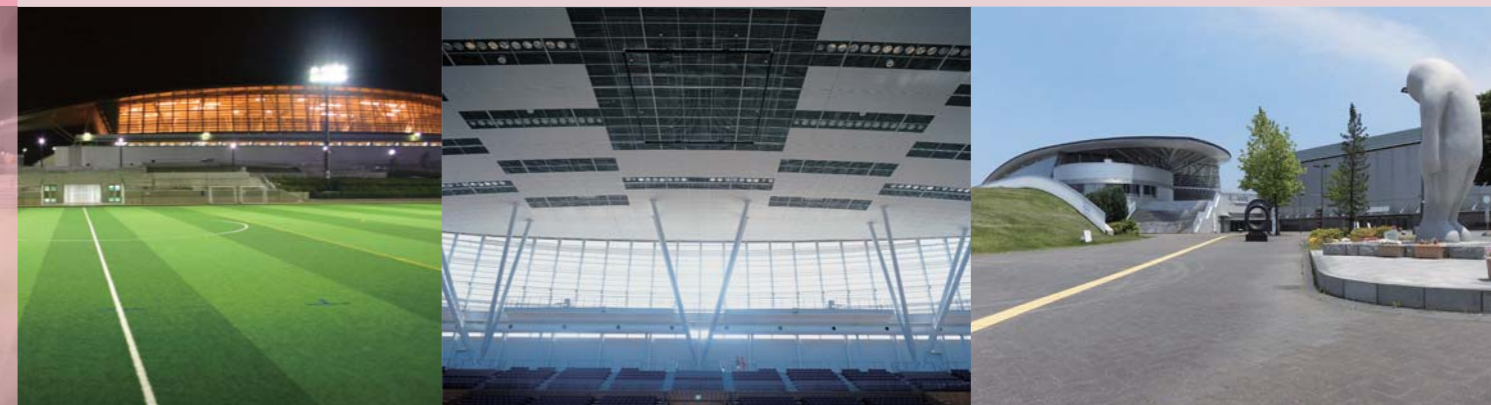

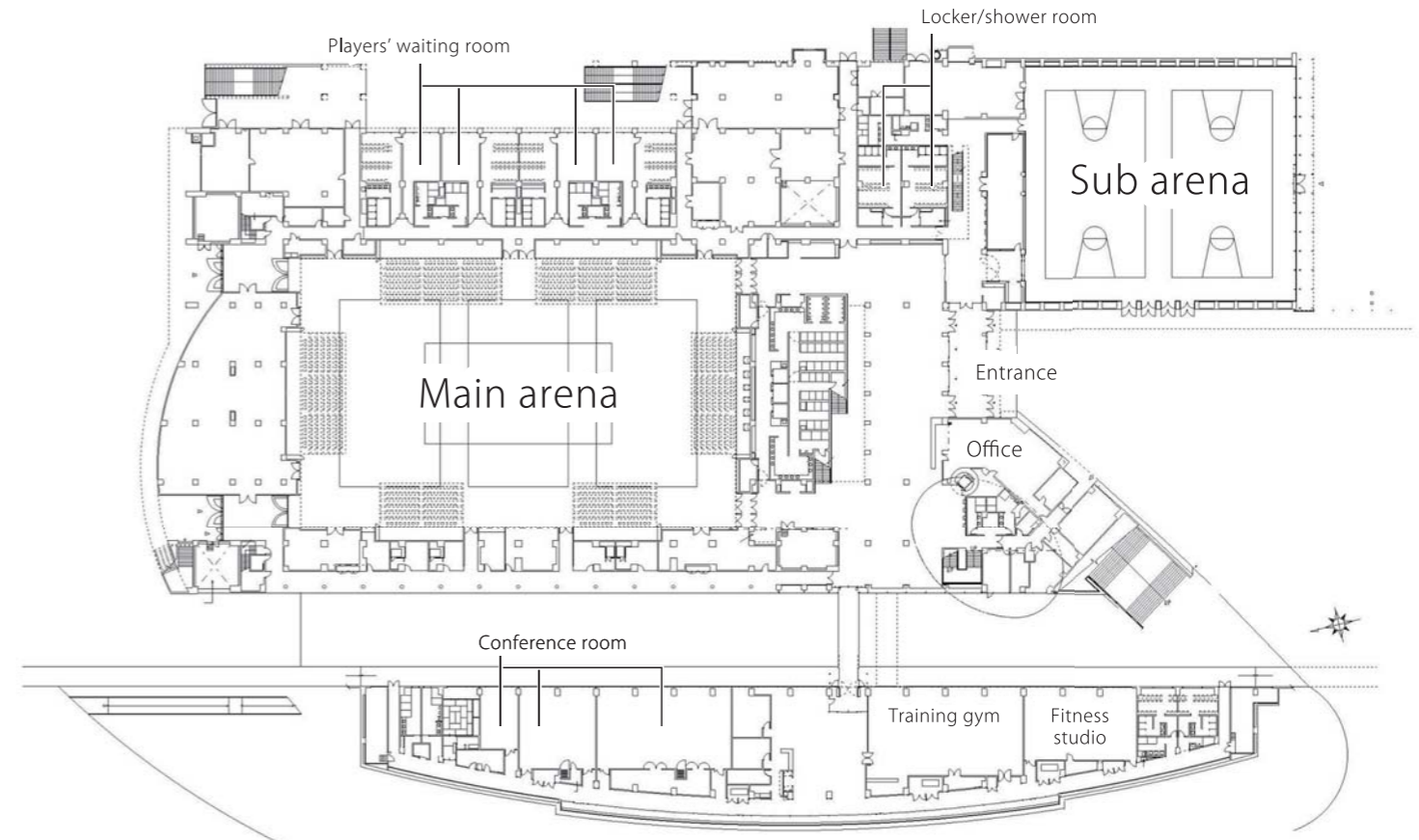


Area 2,600m² | Main arena

Total floor area: 2,600 m² (40m×65m), Ceiling height: 20 m,

Opening/closing type windows to take in natural light and wind, and roll type screens to block light are installed.

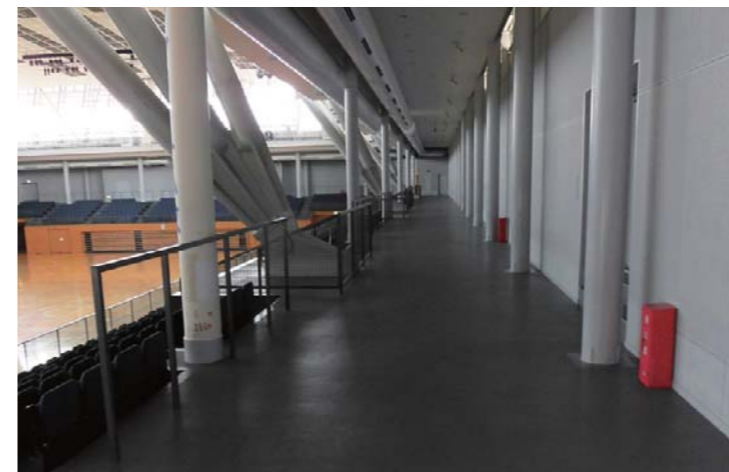

A total of 58 machines of 32 kinds, including full-fledged muscle training machines



Conference room
Up to 88 people can be accommodated. Audio equipment, a projector and a large screen are also installed.



Players' waiting room
Four rooms are available. Each room has 96 lockers and 4 showers.



Locker/shower room
A shower room with lockers is available both for men and women. Each room has 54 lockers and 4 showers.
