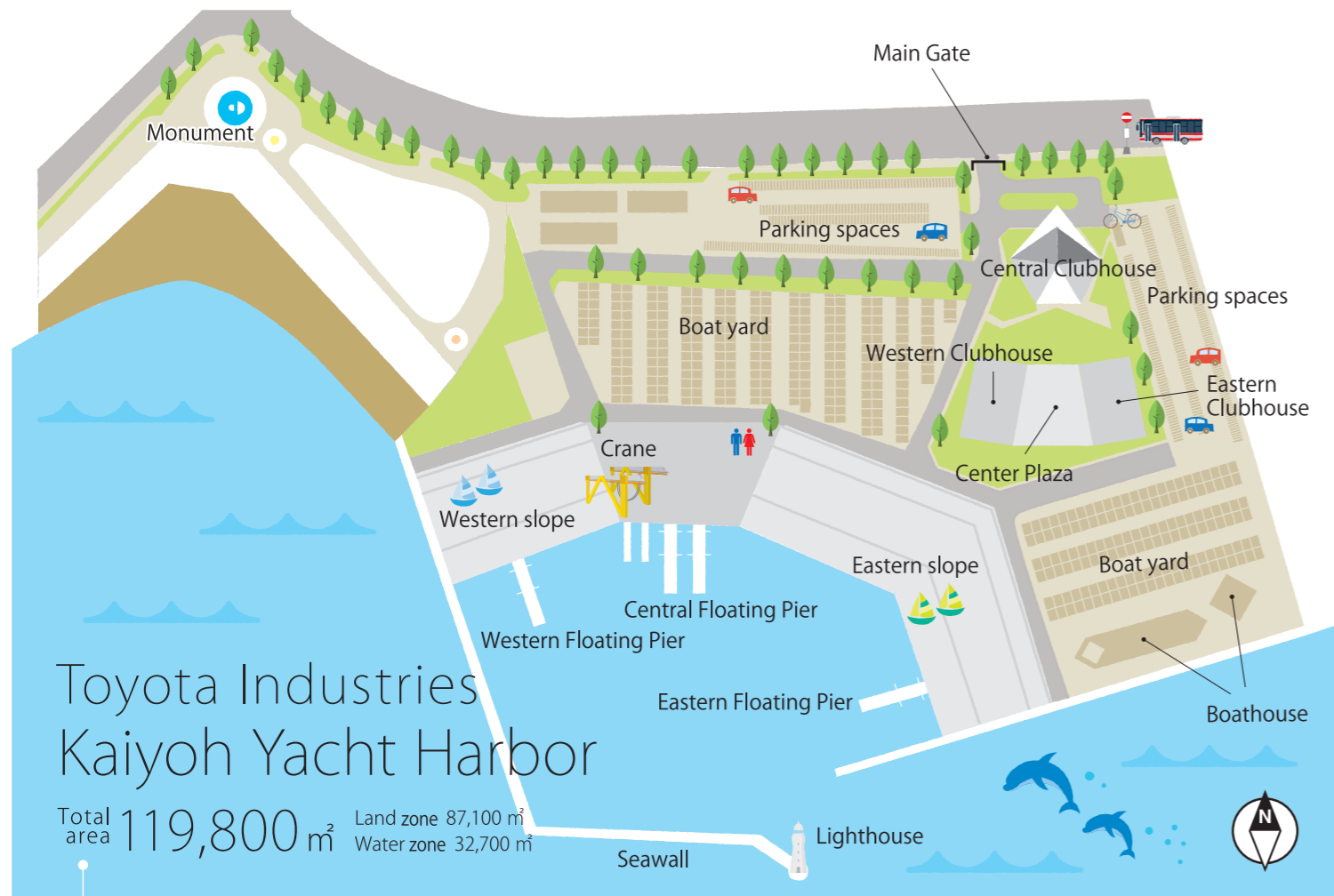

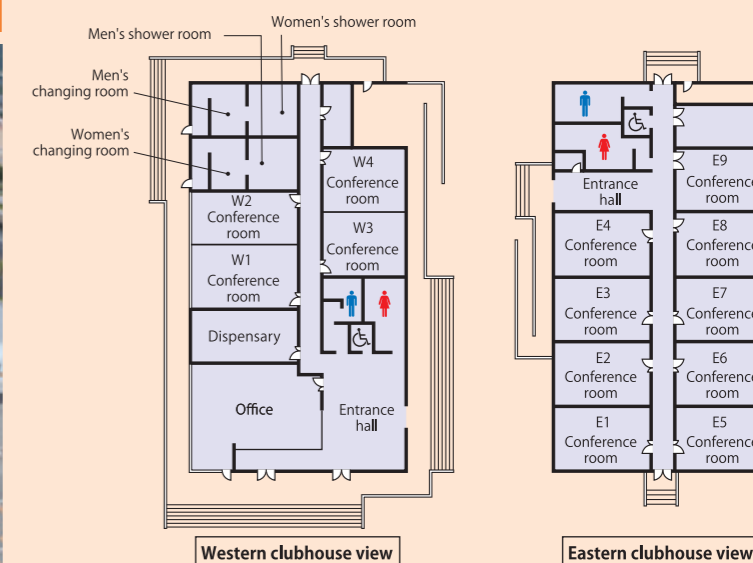
## Toyota Industries Kaiyoh Yacht Harbor

This is one of the few facilities in Japan where international competitions can be held, and the east and west boat lift yards boast a capacity of the largest class in Japan. Construction in 2017 added clubhouses, a boathouse, and floating piers.

### Wheelchair accessible ramp Manbou

- First wheelchair accessible pontoon in Japan
- The bridge connecting the floating pier and the land is moderately sloped and anti-slip paved.
- The landing pier is equipped with a lifter to assist the disabled with boarding.
- To the floating pier (5 m wide, 24 m long), three yachts or motor boats can be moored.
