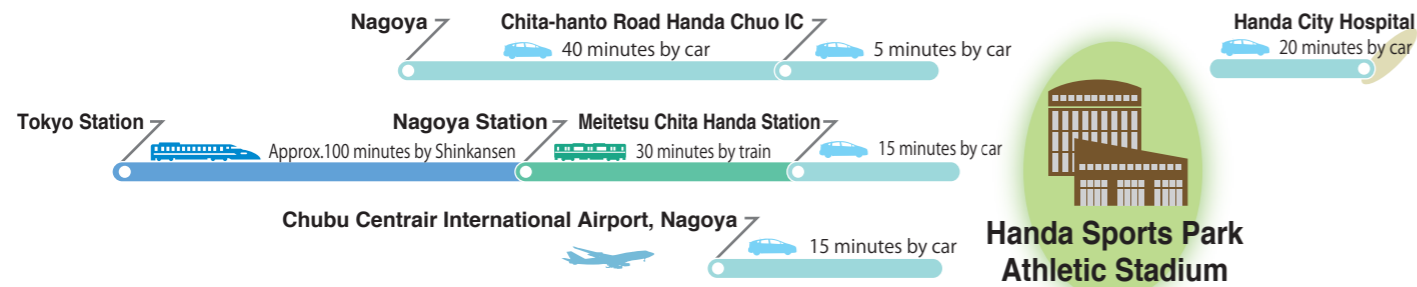

Brewery Warehouses "Kura-no-Machi"

Lanes run alongside the blackboard brewery storehouses. These warehouses, standing by the Handa Canal, were made to store vinegar. They remain as images of the old Edo-period. The lanes are perfect for strolling. You may feel the change of seasons with the sea breeze.

Handa City, Aichi Prefecture

Located in the eastern Chita peninsula, Handa is easily accessible from both Nagoya city and CHUBU CENTRAIR International Airport. Handa was established in 1937 and the population reached 120,000 in the spring of 2008. Handa had flourished in the shipping and brewing industries for a very long time and it was developing as a central city of politics, economy and culture in Chita area.

The symbols of Handa are "Dashi" (floats), "Kura" (warehouses), "Nankichi" (a famous author from Handa) and "Red Brick Building". Dashi festival in Handa has over 300 years of history and its traditions have been passed down from generation to generation.

Track and Field, Football, Rugby

This training facility meets the requirement of National Federation of Athletics, and is a 3rd grade facility certified by the Japan Association of Athletics Federations.
Track: 400 meters by 9 lanes, all-weather polyurethane paving (in rain: approx. 50 meters by 6 lanes)
Field: 106 m x 69.5 m, covered with Tifton grass (available for football, rugby and American football games)
Nighttime lighting: 4 towers, 3,074 seats in the main stand including 14 seats for the disabled

Multi-purpose recreational field

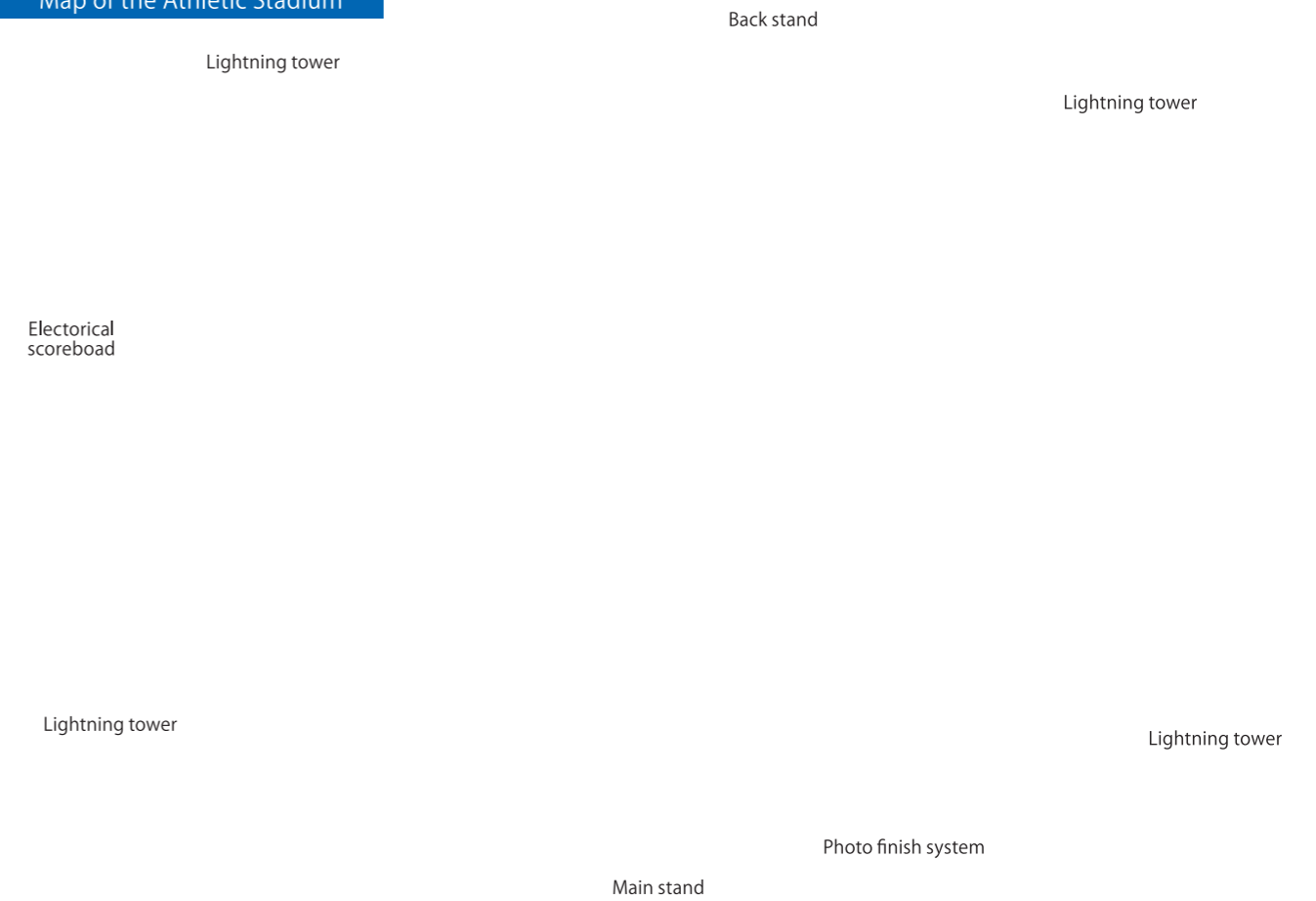
Area 20,700 m²

Handa Sports Park Athletic Stadium

The park is easy to access as it is located within 15 minutes by car from Chubu Centrair International Airport, Nagoya and 40 minutes by car from Nagoya City. Handa Sports Park is equipped with athletic stadium, multi-purpose recreational field, tennis courts, day-camp site, outdoor stage and child park.
